SD 2022/0189	Liquor Licensing and Publication Entertainment Act 2021 (Appointed Day) (No.1) Order 2022
Tynwald Sitting	July 2022
Made:	28 June 2022
Explanatory Note:	<p>This Order brings into operation sections 7(1), 7(2)(a), 7(3), 8 and 9 of the Liquor Licensing and Public Entertainments Act 2021 (“2021 Act”). Section 7(1) and (2)(a) of the 2021 Act confirms that there continues to be constituted the Licensing Court but that it now consists of the High Bailiff and at least 2 but not more than 4 justices. Under section 7(3) of the 2021 Act, the Licensing Court’s function is to determine applications for licences or such other functions as are conferred on it under the 2021 Act or any other enactment.</p> <p>Section 8 of the 2021 Act confirms that there continues to be constituted a court called the Licensing Court of Appeal (the “Appeal Court”), which consists of a Deemster and 2 other members, who must be appointed by the Clerk of the Rolls.</p> <p>Section 9 of the 2021 Act re-enacts section 3(1) and (2) of the Licensing Act 1995 and provides that the Licensing Court and the Appeal Court are courts of justice and courts of record and, subject to any provision in or under the 2021 Act, the Licensing Court and the Appeal Court may act on their own knowledge of the wants or requirements of a locality or neighbourhood, or of visitors to the Island.</p> <p>This Order also commences section 64(1) of, and Schedule 1 to, the 2021 Act for the purpose only of repealing sections 1, 2, 3 and 5(4)(a) and (c) of, and Schedule 1 to, the Licensing Act 1995 (“1995 Act”).</p>

 Explanatory Note: This Order brings into operation the Statute Law Revision Act 2021 in its entirety. That Act will commence immediately after this Order is made.

SD 2022/0193 Sexual Offences and Obscene Publication Act 2021 (Appointed Day) (No.1) Order 2022
 Tynwald Sitting July 2022
 Made: 22 June 2022
 Explanatory Note: This Order brings into operation Part 11 (pardons and disregards) of the Sexual Offences and Obscene Publications Act 2021 on 29 June 2022. (Sections 1 and 2 of that Act came into operation on its announcement day.)
 Part 11 provides for the pardoning of persons convicted of certain historical sexual offences and for a process by which persons may apply to have those convictions disregarded.
