CIVIL SERVICE (AMENDMENT) ACT 2007

AN ACT to amend the constitution of the Civil Service Commission; to extend the power of the Chief Minister to give directions to the Commission; to require the Commission to submit reports to the Chief Minister; to make certain officers ineligible for membership of departments, statutory boards and certain public bodies; and for connected purposes.

1 Amendment of constitution of Civil Service Commission

[Amends section 2 of the *Civil Service Act 1990* as follows: paragraph (a) substitutes subsections (1), (2), (3), (3A) and (3B) for paragraphs (1), (2) and (3); paragraph (b) amends subsection (4) by repealing the words ‘chairman of the’; and paragraph (c) repeals subsection (8)(a).]

2 Amendment of power for Chief Minister to give directions to Commission

[Amends section 2(7) of the *Civil Service Act 1990* by repealing the words ‘in relation to any matter which appears to him to affect the public interest.’.]

3 Commission to submit reports

[Amends section 2 of the *Civil Service Act 1990* by adding subsections (9) and (10).]

4 Membership of departments, statutory boards, etc.

(1) In section 1 of the *Civil Service Act 1990*, at the end add —

‘ (6) Subject to subsection (7), no member of the Civil Service and no officer or employee of a Department, a statutory board or a body specified in an order made under section 4(1)(a) of the *Payment of Members’ Expenses Act 1989* shall be eligible to be a member of a Department, a statutory board or such a specified body.

- (7) Subsection (6) shall not affect —
- (a) the chief executive officer of the Financial Supervision Commission;
 - (b) the chief executive officer of the Insurance and Pensions Authority;
 - (c) a person, a Department, a statutory board or a body specified for the purposes of this subsection in an order made by the Council of Ministers and approved by Tynwald.’
- (2) In Schedule 1 of the *Electricity Act 1996* subsection 3(3) is repealed.¹

5 Membership of Commission: transitional

- (1) Notwithstanding section 1, the chairperson and members of the Civil Service Commission who are in office immediately before the date on which this Act comes into operation (‘commencement’) shall remain in office until the date specified in subsection (2).
- (2) The date referred to in subsection (1) is —
- (a) in the case of the chairperson, the date of the first appointment of a chairperson after commencement;
 - (b) in the case of the vice-chairperson (if any), the date of the first appointment of a vice-chairperson after commencement;
 - (c) in the case of any other member, the date of the first appointment of a member after commencement;
 - (d) the date on which that person would have gone out of office if this Act had not been passed, or
 - (e) if the person resigns or is removed from office, the date on which the resignation or removal takes effect,
- whichever is first.

6 Short title and commencement

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Civil Service (Amendment) Act 2007.
- (2) Section 4 shall come into operation on such day as the Council of Ministers may by order appoint.
