

# UK Borders Act 2007

## 2007 CHAPTER 30

An Act to make provision about immigration and asylum; and for connected purposes.

[30<sup>th</sup> October 2007]

Provisions of the UK Borders Act 2007 (of Parliament) may be extended to the Isle of Man, with modifications, as provided for in section 60(4) of the Act.

- “(4) Her Majesty may by Order in Council direct that a provision of this Act is to extend, with or without modification or adaptation, to—
- (a) any of the Channel Islands;
  - (b) the Isle of Man..”
