# **PLANT BREEDERS' RIGHTS (FARM SAVED SEED) (SPECIFICATION OF SPECIES AND GROUPS) ORDER 2022<sup>1</sup>**

*Approved by Tynwald: 17 May 2022*  
*Coming into Operation: in accordance with article 2*

The Department of Environment, Food and Agriculture makes the following Order under sections 9(2) and 48(1) of the Plant Varieties Act 1997 (of Parliament), as extended to the Island<sup>1</sup>.

## **1 Title**

This Order is the Plant Breeders' Rights (Farm Saved Seed) (Specification of Species and Groups) Order 2022.

## **2 Commencement**

If approved by Tynwald<sup>2</sup>, this Order comes into operation on the day after it is approved.

## **3 Specification of species and groups**

The species and groups listed in the Schedule to this Order are specified for the purposes of section 9(2) of the Plant Varieties Act 1997 (of Parliament), as extended to the Island<sup>3</sup>.
